

SAS PERSONAL DATA PRIVACY POLICY

When you apply for or renew membership of the Singapore Actuarial Society (the Society), it will be deemed that you acknowledge and accept the Personal Data Privacy (PDP) Policy of the Society.

The Personal Data Privacy Policy of the Singapore Actuarial Society (the Society)

The Society processes any member's personal data provided by the member only for legitimate purposes which include:

- Compliance with a legal obligation.
- Purposes relating to its role as a professional association which include but are not limited to the:
 - o Collection of annual subscriptions and other membership fees.
 - o Establishment of the class of membership.
 - o Registration at events organised by the Society.
 - o Confirmation of the member's membership of the Society to external parties.
 - o Circulation of notices and announcements pertinent to the functions of the Society, e.g. of notices of general meetings and of announcements of events organised by the Society or by any other organisation whose events are sanctioned by the Council of the Society.

The Society will take all reasonable care and precautions to safeguard the personal data of members, or any other person, which the Society has taken possession of. The Society will not release any personal data to any other party without the consent of the person to whom the data pertains, except when required to do so to comply with the law.

Any member will always have the right to inspect her or his personal data held by the Society and require the Society to make corrections in there are any errors in the data.

If any person registers for any event organised by the Society or by any other organisation whose event is sanctioned by the Council of the Society, his or her registration may be made known to other parties, with information on the name of his or her employer or firm (if any) and on his or her country of residence. This person will also be deemed to have given consent to:

- Receiving information and publicity related to the event from the Society or any other organisation with which the Society engages in the organisation and conduct of this event.
- His or her image being captured by photographers or videographers, engaged by the organiser of the event to record the proceedings of the event, which may be made public in publications or on the websites of the Society or of any organisation which the Society engages in the organisation and conduct of this event.
